

2015 Kids' Annual Fishing Contest

There has been interest in changing the dates of the Annual Kids' Season Long Fishing Contest to run for a full 12 months.

The PCLIA Kid's Season Long Fishing Contest for 2015 will run from **July 15, 2014** through **July 14, 2015**. All entries for the Kid's Season Long Fishing Contest must be registered no later than Tuesday, **July 15, 2015**.

The rules for the PCLIA Kids' Season Long Fishing Contest will remain the same as in years' past, and all children ages 15 and under are eligible to enter. The awards for the Annual Kids' Fishing Contest will be given out at the 10th Annual PCLIA Fish Fry, on **Saturday, August 1, 2015**.

The Kid's One-Day-Fishing Contest will be held **Sunday, May 24, 2015**. This is the day before Memorial Day. During the One-Day contest, children can submit entries caught on that day. Note that these entries are not eligible for the Annual Kids' Fishing Contest if they are entered for the One-Day Contest.

THE RULES

1. Contest runs July 15, 2014 - July 14, 2015. Entry deadline is July 15, 2015.
2. Age limit – 15 and under.
3. Entries must be from PCLIA members and their families.
4. Fish caught in our chain of lakes only.
5. Six species of fish qualify: Northern, Walleye, Bass, Crappie, Sunfish and Perch.
6. Fish entries from the One Day Take a Kid Fishing Contest do not qualify.
7. Winner is determined by overall length. In case of tie, winner will be determined by the earliest postmark.
8. All entries must be witnessed by a family member or person present at the time of the catch.
9. All winners' prizes will be awarded at the 10th Annual Fish Fry on August 1, 2015 which starts at 1pm.
